- 12. Your story is set in ____. Why did you choose that as the setting for your book?
- 13. If your book was to be made into a movie, who are the celebrities that would star in it?
- 14. Was the writing process different and what challenges did you face writing xxx genre? (*when writing in a new genre*)
- 15. Can you give us some insight into what makes ____ character tick?
- 16. What were the key challenges you faced when writing this book?
- 17. What was the highlight of writing this book?
